Solent Airport - notice of pre-planning application

From 25 July to 19 August, Fareham Borough Council will be consulting on a proposal to install lights on the runway at Solent Airport. This is a pre-application consultation which means that any comments made can be taken into account before the design is finalised. The consultation will be live on the Council's website from midday on 25 July www.fareham.gov.uk/daedalus/aglscheme.aspx and information panels about the scheme will be on display in the Cafe@05 and Fareham Innovation Centre.
